Overcoming Evil with Good

Scripture: Romans 12:9-21

Discipleship Questions:

- 1. What is your experience of reading this list of directives in Romans 12:9-21? Which one is easier for you to follow and live? Why? Which of the directives do you struggle to do? Why? I encourage you to share authentically. Our own awareness of where we need to grow is a good place to begin transformation, inspired by the Holy Spirit.
- 2. In the message, Pastor Laura talked about two opposing images that drive how we are able to offer grace to other people and overcome evil with good. First, we allow others not to be God; we allow them to be broken just as we are broken. Second, the Christ in us sees the Christ in others. Christ's love lights up and shines through our brokenness. How do these ideas impact how you treat other people, specifically those you may see as "enemies"?
- 3. Where will you begin prayer walking in Waupun? Pray for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes and your heart to love the people you encounter.
