Discipleship Questions

1. Penned by Charles Wesley, the hymn, *Come Thou Long Expected Jesus*, states that Jesus was "Born to set Thy people free." This line refers to the bondage of sin for which Jesus died to release us. What does it mean to be set free from sin? Is it more than just being forgiven and promised heaven? How does your life reflect that you have been set free from sin?
2. In John 6, the Jewish people misunderstood Jesus' kingship. They wanted Him to be the king of Israel, which failed to comprehend that Jesus' kingship was greater than ruling a nation. As you reflect on this, what does it mean for Jesus to be king of your life? Are there any areas of your life not under the kingship of Jesus? If so, how might God want to bring transformation to your life today?
